Dear Parent/Carer,

Following the presentation this week regarding the very exciting Beach School project, I am pleased to confirm details to you. We have allocated Cygnets class to attend Beach School every morning of week commencing 21st May, and Goslings class to attend during each afternoon.

As discussed during the meeting, our Parent-Teacher Association 'Friends of Park' have been very kind and have purchased a t-shirt and cap for every child to wear at beach school. These will be kept in school. Should you wish to have more information on the fund-raising activities of 'Friends of Park' please do not hesitate to approach any member of staff on the playground in the mornings.

On the morning of Beach School, please consider the weather and dress your child appropriately. Your child will also require a bag with a change of clothes and a bottle of water for the trip. As you are aware, weather in England is somewhat changeable so please bear this in mind! Please also ensure that you have fully coated your child in sun cream each morning. For Goslings class there will be a sun cream top up session after lunch therefore, please send in your child's sun cream, clearly labelled in the mornings. We will send your child home with their sun cream each day.

I have attached a copy of the slide shown at the meeting with recommendations of clothing. It is recommended that children have beach shoes for this part of the curriculum, however trainers will suffice if this is not possible. No flip flops or sandals to be worn for safety reasons.

As Beach School Leader, I will be checking tidal forecasts and weather conditions for Harrison Drive Beach on the days that we will be visiting. Should it be deemed necessary to cancel Beach School due to environmental conditions, a text will be sent to you. Children will then take part in normal lessons at school.

I am sure you will agree that this is an exciting learning opportunity for the children which aims to improve their confidence and communication skills. Please sign and return the attached consent form prior to your child's first Beach School session.
