School Uniform

- Plain black shorts, leggings or jogging bottoms
- Trainers or pumps

We wanted to give you this information before you buy any uniform over the summer as we will be raising our expectation for everyone to wear the full uniform from September (including no trainers). Anyone not wearing this will be asked to change into some of the spare uniform we keep in school, so please don't waste your money on items such as trainers that they will not be able to wear. To keep costs down, you are welcome to purchase plain jumpers and cardigans in royal blue; there is no expectation you have the Park logo on these.
