Y5 Forest School Sessions at Park

Dear Parents and Carers,

Park has been really proud to be a Forest School for the past two years and we are excited to continue them this year working with GROW-Wellbeing.

Y5 will be attending 10 Forest School sessions on the following Fridays:

- 10th September, 17th September, 24th September, 1st October, 8th October, 15th October. 22nd October, 5th November, 12th November, 19th November

They should come to school on a Friday wearing the following:

- Warm clothing (ideally layered: vest, t-shirt, fleece/hoodie)
- Waterproof coat
- Boots, trainers or wellies, for when it’s raining (and a spare pair of trainers/shoes to change into after the session)

**In the event of bad weather, it may be beneficial to bring spare socks in! School will provide waterproof trousers to go over their clothes.*

The children will be outside for 1 hour in all types of weather and will be learning new skills such as fire building, den making and rope skills whilst also looking at areas of the National Curriculum such as habitats, pollination and growth. During these sessions the children will be learning how to solve problems, keep safe and be resilient in team contexts.
